Description

When installing GitCoat (<https://f-droid.org/packages/com.commit451.gitlab/>) through F-Droid the phone doesn't respond anymore and reboots at some time.

The Replicant splash screen then appears for more than several minutes until the preparation of all apps starts. After the preparation the splash screen appears again without any sign of booting the system and either prepares again the apps or boots the system. When trying to start GitCoat the whole procedure starts again.
